### Introduction

Thank you for your interest in Columbia County Christian School. The selection of a school to educate your child involves research, prayerful consideration and diligence to make the right choice.

We are happy to assist you in the process to learn if our school meets your needs.

An education at Columbia County Christian is a rewarding experience. A strong core curriculum supplemented by extracurricular activities provides our students a meaningful and varied education. CCCS students experience a curriculum with a heavy emphasis on academic and critical thinking, skill development, spiritual formation and a Biblical Worldview.

### Admissions Process

#### STUDENTS NEW TO CCCS MUST DO THE FOLLOWING:

- Complete Paper Application
- Provide copy of Birth certificate (Prep-K and Kindergarten only) to the office.
- Provide copy of Immunization card (Prep-K and Kindergarten only) to the office
- Turn in Completed Prep-K and Kindergarten checklist (Prep-K and Kindergarten only)
- Records transfer request (grades 1-8)
- Turn in Criminal background check form (1 per parent or guardian)
- Registration and Society Fees –\$350 (per student/non-refundable) (\$200 society fee & is tax deductible)

#### ALL PARENTS AND 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> GRADE STUDENTS MUST ATTEND BACK TO SCHOOL ORIENTATION IN AUGUST

(If you are unable to attend, please schedule a meeting with the administrator to review school policies and procedures before the school year begins)

CCCS cannot meet the needs of all students. While we desire to be a blessing to all, and respect the value of every child, we cannot adequately accommodate the highly specialized needs of some students who are academically or behaviorally challenged. The administrator will review all admissions and has the final say regarding their acceptance.

New students enrolling in 3rd through 8th grade may be tested in reading and math to ensure CCCS can meet their needs. Please schedule a testing time with the administrator.

\*Prep-K \$294/month for 5 days a week

\$189/month for 3 days a week

\$158/month for 2 days a week

\*Elementary & Middle School: \$5,408 or \$540.80/month for 10 months  
(Grades K-8)

### **Discounts:**

**Early registration:** 5% if tuition is paid in full before September 7, 2021

**Multifamily:** First child is full tuition  
Second child is 10% discount  
Third child is 20% discount  
Fourth and up are 30% discount

**Volunteer 30 hours:** Each family is required to volunteer at least 30 hours a school year. Volunteering gives parents an opportunity to become more involved and helps us achieve the mission of our school.
